Who is IDADA?

IDADA, the Indianapolis Downtown Artists and Dealers Association, is a 501(c)(6) non-profit membership-based organization of artists, art galleries, and arts-related businesses within the 20-block radius of the center of Indianapolis.

What does IDADA do?

The primary focus of IDADA is the creation and marketing of unique and original local art. IDADA's mission is to:

How does IDADA operate?

IDADA Memberships

Artist (\$50) - An individual visual artist that lives or has a studio within the IDADA operating area. Artist members must at some time during the year have their studios open to the public or exhibit in the IDADA area during an IDADA First Friday Art Tour.

Art Gallery (\$100) - A business that is located within the IDADA operating area, that is dedicated to selling fine art, and that has specific gallery hours that are open to the public.

Arts-Related Business (\$100) - A business that is located within the IDADA operating area and that directly serves the visual arts community.

Friend of IDADA (non-voting memberships)

Associate Level (\$50) - An artist or individual that wishes to support the mission of IDADA but is from outside the IDADA operating area or is not in an arts-related field.

Business Level (\$100) - A business that wishes to support the mission of IDADA but is located outside the IDADA operating area or is not an arts-related business.
